B. Considérez: Réfléchissez, discutez.

- The newly-arrived French depended on the Native people for many things. Make a list of what the French might have needed for survival, that the Native people knew or had.
- Why do you think the Native people felt that the territory where they lived did not change “owners” even though the French had declared it French territory?
- Why did the “habitants” continue to speak French? Why were fur traders able to continue their work when *la Nouvelle France* changed to British or Spanish hands?
- Are there place names in your area that are of French origin? Are there place names of Native origin? Can you find out more about the reasons for these place names? If they are the names of persons, who were those persons?

C. Projet

- Using “ThingLink” or a similar program, put together an interactive map of your area showing when French explorers entered the region. Be sure to indicate what Native tribes these explorers encountered.
- Present your research on your area’s French-related history in a public forum such as a bulletin board or display case, or a program in your school.
